This is a Horse Council of B.C. General Performance competition, and will be governed by the rules. Tack - according to HCBC rules, dress - casual. Helmets and suitable boots are mandatory. Boots & bandages are allowed. Please send a **photocopy of your HCBC membership** card with your entry (mandatory). **Closing date: May 27<sup>th</sup>, 2011.**

You may ride any current USEF test, and any test twice – to a maximum of 4 from no more than two consecutive levels. All tests are the USEF 2011 Dressage Tests. They are also available on the internet at [www.usef.org](http://www.usef.org). Two Walk-Trot tests are offered. **RIDES ARE LIMITED TO A TOTAL OF 50 FOR THE DAY** so enter early.

For all tests the ring will be 20x60. Ride times will be available after 5:00 PM, Thursday, June 2<sup>nd</sup> via e-mail at [info@lovablebassets.com](mailto:info@lovablebassets.com). The entry secretary will not return calls about ride times due to time and cost constraints. Ride times will be sent to entrants who provide an email addresses.

Ribbons will be awarded to 4th place according to percentages earned.

Stabling is available in secure, but limited Paddocks. **Please notify the secretary if you will arrive the previous night. A charge of \$5/night per paddock.**

Entry fees are \$15.00 per test. Entries will be refunded in full up to the entry deadline. After the entry deadline, entry money will be refunded, less \$10.00, upon presentation of a veterinary or medical certificate before 8:00 am the day of the show.

## ENTRY CHECKLIST

- I have read and agreed to all rules pertaining to this show. I agree to be bound by these rules and agree to conduct myself by these rules.
- I have entered the correct age category-(the age you will be January 1, **2010**) & included date of birth for Junior rider.
- I have signed and dated the correct waiver, and included all copies of current HCBC membership cards for both the Owner and the Rider. Have both the rider and parent signed the entry form unless the rider is 19 and over? All riders regardless of age must sign the form
- I agree that I am responsible for entering the correct classes and that I am responsible for any errors or omissions on the entry form.
- I have completed the stabling form and included all stall deposits and stabling fees.
- I have included all applicable show fees.
- I agree to submit the Heritage Log Book to the office at the start of the show and to retrieve the log book at the closing of the show. I agree that it is my responsibility to ensure the correct placing are recorded before leaving the show grounds
- If I want to collect points for another association, I will hand in a completed form with all classes that I have entered on the form to the Entry Secretary prior to the show. If forms are not completed correctly, no points will be recorded.
- If applying for Heritage Log Book, I agree to do this at the start of the show, that any class placing prior to the application signed and paid for WILL NOT BE RECORDED.
- Have you included a separate stall deposit cheque? You must include a cheque for **each** horse if you are stabling.

21. While mounted on a horse, **all Juniors MUST wear** ASTM approved headgear with chinstrap engaged on competition or event ground

22. ASTM Helmet with secure harness and chinstrap is mandatory for all riders when in jumping classes and warm up.

23. A maximum of eight horses will Gallop in the ring at one time.

24. A maximum of twelve horses will Canter/Lope.

25. Pewee, Junior, & Intermediate classes may or may not be split/combined, depending on the number of entries (**Four+**); Trail, western riding, reining, & hunter jumper, will **not** be split.

26. A **beginner rider is in their first year of showing**, & has not entered a class requiring a canter or loop (walk,trot,canter)

27. A **Novice rider** has not won **THREE first place ribbons** in equitation (regardless of discipline; ie Hunter Equitation, Western Horsemanship, Stock seat, etc) Please respect the honour system!

28. A **Maiden Horse** has not won a first place in that division.

29. A **Green Horse** is in their first year under saddle.

30. An **Amateur Rider** is a rider who makes no income from lessons, instruction or training.

31. Lunging in designated areas only.

### **PRIZES**

Ribbons will be awarded to sixth place. Stakes classes will award cash awards.

No Prizes will be awarded unless expressly written in Show Prizelist/Program, excepting competitor door prizes and volunteer, sportsmanship awards. Any awards **MUST** have expectations and responsibilities listed in prize list.
