Jumping Classes:

Clear Round: All clear rounds will receive a ribbon. This class is intended to offer riders an opportunity to school over a competitive course.

Power and Speed: This competition has two sections of jumps within the posted course. The 1st set is for power, the 2nd set is timed immediately after landing from the last jump of the power set. In equality of faults for the entire course fastest time in the speed portion wins.

Match the Clock: Placings for equal faults will be determined by closest to the Optimum Time.

Fault and Out : Course ridden as many times as possible in 60 seconds. After whistle blows (60 Sec) rider takes the next jump. Most jumps cleared is the winner; in equality of jumps cleared fastest time determines winner. If knockdown during round, take next jump to stop the clock; if refusal go through finish line to stop the clock.

Fault and Out Team Relay: Each team has two competitors. The course shown on the plan must be jumped as many times as possible until the whistle blows (80 sec). A change over is compulsory when the first rider has completed his round, or when a fault is committed. When a fault is committed the other rider must take over where the disobedience occurred or at the next fence if a knockdown is committed. Riders continue to alternate as/if their partner commits a fault or completes a round. When the whistle blows (80 sec) rider jumps the next fence to stop the clock.

20. All tack requirements and restrictions of respective divisions will be in accordance of current EC rule books. Knowledge of the rules is the responsibility of the competitor. Please direct questions regarding the rules and regulations to the Steward or Show Managers.

21. While mounted on a horse, **all Juniors MUST wear** ASTM approved headgear with chinstrap engaged on competition or event ground

22. ASTM Helmet with secure harness and chinstrap is mandatory for all riders when in jumping classes and warm up.

23. Lunging in designated areas only.

PRIZES

Ribbons will be awarded to sixth place.

Stakes classes will award cash awards.

Hunter/Jumper Division High Point and Reserve are calculated as follows:

1st – 7 points

2nd – 5 points

3rd – 4 points

4th – 3 points

5th – 2 points

6th – 1 point

No Prizes will be awarded unless expressly written in Show Prize list/Program, excepting competitor door prizes and volunteer, sportsmanship awards. Any awards **MUST** have expectations and responsibilities listed in prize list.

General Show Rules

1. 2011 Shows will be guided by Current HCBC rule book. Show Committee reserves the right to change/amend the rules and to decide on any point not covered by these rules. Copies of HCBC Membership cards must be included with Entry. A 100 Mile & District Outrider's membership card must accompany entry form to be excluded from paying the non-member fee of \$10.
2. Age Categories (age as of January 1, 2011) Pewee – 8 & under
Junior – 9 to 13 Intermediate – 14 to 18 Senior – 19 & over
3. **It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to have read and understood all the rules both current HCBC and club show rules. They will be strictly adhered to.**
 - a. *Mistreatment of any horse on the grounds,*
 - b. *abusive or foul language,*
 - c. *use of alcohol or drugs*
 - d. *discourteous behavior to fellow entrants or show personnel,*by contestants, parents, or guardians, and coaches, will be excused from the show and removed from the grounds, forfeiting their entry fees/prizes.
SPORTSMANSHIP IS PARAMOUNT!
4. Outside assistance or coaching from the sidelines, will cause elimination of the competitor being assisted while in that class.
5. The use of communication devices while competitor is in competition ring is illegal and will result in elimination!
6. Disputes will be as outlined in the EC rule book or at judges and show management discretion. Any disputes are to be made in writing, accompanied by a fee of \$100. If dispute is valid, fee is to be returned.
7. Management reserves the right to cancel, combine or split all classes.
8. NO REFUNDS will be given without a Vet/Dr.'s certificate.
9. **Post entries will be accepted up to four classes prior to the class being entered. An additional fee will apply to ALL post entries.**
10. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to report to the whipper-in in the holding area when the class is called, the gate will not be held.
11. Horses must be KEPT AT A WALK except when in the Warm up and show rings.
12. If dogs **MUST** accompany entrant, they must be leashed or crated.
13. Stallions are **NOT** to be handled by minors!(under 19)
14. Unruly horses will be excused.
15. The same horse may only be shown in Junior and Senior divisions in showmanship and equitation classes.
16. Entrants must display their numbers at **ALL TIMES!**
17. Contact information will be posted for all stabled/paddock horses.
18. Lunch breaks should be held at a duration TBA.
19. Standard English/Western attire/tack, in respective classes encouraged. Riding boots are Mandatory, chaps are optional.

- Jumper - \$8.00 per class or \$30.00 per Division
- Team Relay - \$12.00 per Team– Add Back
- **Post entries will be accepted up to *start of Division of class entering at class cost plus \$5.00. ADD BACK Classes must be entered prior to Division begins.* Post entries go first in their class.**
- To qualify for Add Back class, you must complete the entire division.
- Competitors are allowed to compete in **one** full division each day. A horse may compete in **individual** consecutive height classes one class below their division and/or up to three classes above their division.

- Non Member fee of \$10.00 Applies to all entrants not members of 100 Mile & District Outriders
- NSF cheques are subject to a \$25 penalty.
- An Office Fee of \$5.00 Applies to all entries.
- No entry will be accepted until all fees are paid!!
